## PLACEMENT TEST Q + A

Parents may drop off their student(s) in the circle drive at our East Campus. Doors will open 30 minutes before the test begins, please arrive no later than 15 minutes before the test is scheduled to begin.

#### Q: What should I bring with me?

A: No.2 pencils are required. No calculators may be used on the test.

#### Q: Approximately how long will the test take?

A: The test will take up to three hours. Each section is timed and there will be two, five-minute breaks during the test.

#### Q: Should I study for the test?

A: Students are encouraged to do their best. There is not a study guide.

### Q: What types of questions will be on the test?

A: The test will consist of multiple choice questions in three main sections - reading, language and math.

#### Q: What are the results of the test used for?

A: The results help the counselors determine which classes each student would be best suited for their freshman year.

#### Q: What happens if I do not do well on the test?

A: The placement test is just one piece of information used to help with course placement. The Guidance Team may also consult with parents and junior high teachers for input.
