- **Facts on File** [Issues & Controversies](#) - Explores more than 800 hot topics in business, politics, government, education, and popular culture. (username is lindvall and password is shglibrary)
- **ProQuest** [SIRS Issue Researcher](#) - A student reference database containing thousands of full-text articles exploring social, scientific, health, historic, business, economic, political and global issues. (You will not need a username and password for this database.)
