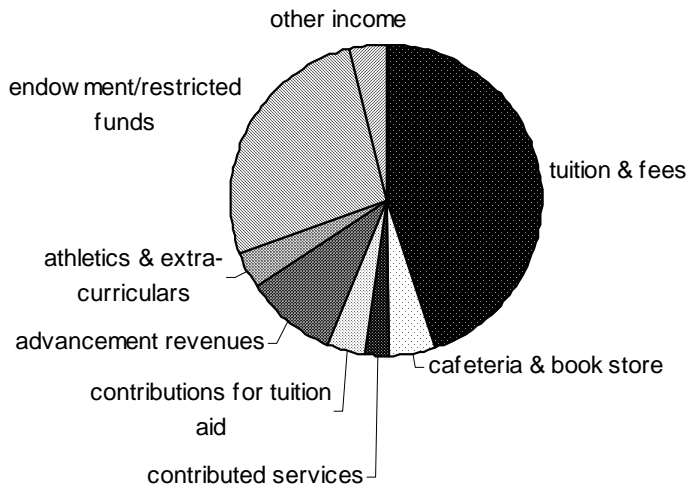

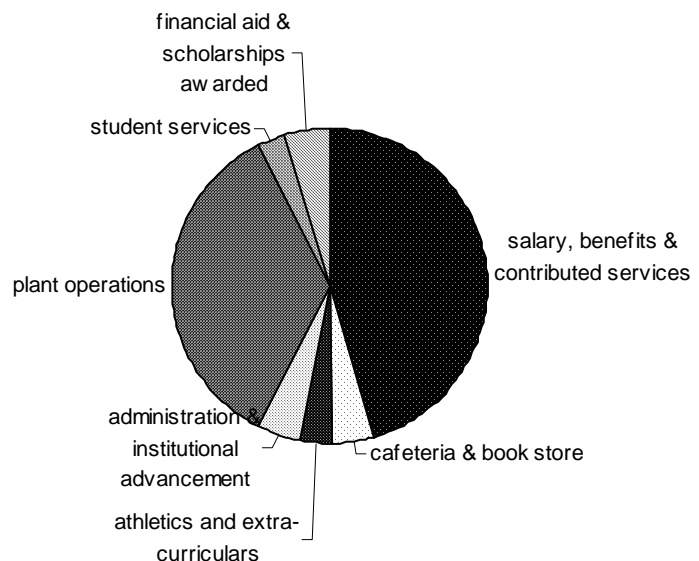

Contributed Services

T

he Springfield Dominicans, the Viatorians and the Diocesan and Dominican priests have supported Sacred Heart Academy, Griffin High School, Cathedral Boys High School and Sacred Heart-Griffin High School by accepting only a fraction of their just salaries. In Fiscal

Year 2004-05, the contributed services of nine Dominican sisters and one Viatorian priest was \$222,827. During the 17 years of SHG, the religious educators have saved the school \$4,278,654 in contributed services. In addition to their contributed service in 2004-2005, the Springfield Dominican Sisters contributed \$250,000 to the Financial Aid and Scholarship Fund.
