



Sacred Heart-Griffin National Honor Society Admissions Requirements

1. **Scholarship:** G.P.A.= weighted of 3.8 or higher
 2. **Character:** Discipline
 - No more than 1 level 1 offense on the student's cumulative discipline record.
 - No level 2 or 3 offenses
 - Levels of offense can be found on page 14 of the student handbook.
 - A student may attach a personal statement to his/her application to address any disciplinary actions they feel warrant further explanation and consideration by the selection committee.
 3. **Service:** 25 hours required. These hours must be completed June 1 - December 1 of the current school year.
 - 10 hours to church
 - 10 hours to community
 - These hours must be completed at a local hospital, food pantry, breadline, library, nursing home, or a non-profit.
 - 5 hours to school
 4. **Leadership:** Current active involvement in 2 or more clubs, sports or organizations.
 - Involvement may include school and/or community activities/organizations.
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In January of the current school year, junior and senior students who meet the above criteria may apply for admission into the SHG chapter of NHS. The completed applications will be reviewed by a 5 person faculty council to ensure applicants demonstrate outstanding scholarship, character, service and leadership.

Those invited to join the SHG chapter of NHS will sign a statement acknowledging their acceptance. While an active member of NHS, students are expected to participate in peer tutoring and other service projects as designated by the NHS faculty advisor.
