



PLACEMENT TEST Q + A

Q: Where should I be dropped off and what time should I arrive?

A: Parents can drop their student(s) off in the circle drive at our East Campus. The doors will be open at 7:30am. All students should arrive by 7:45am. Students will be greeted and directed on where to go when they arrive.

Q: What should I bring with me?

A: No.2 pencils are required. No calculators may be used on the test.

Q: Approximately how long will the test take?

A: The test will take up to three hours. Each section is timed and there will be two, five-minute breaks during the test.

Q: Should I study for the test?

A: Students are encouraged to do their best. There is not a study guide.

Q: What types of questions will be on the test?

A: The test will consist of multiple choice questions in three main sections - reading, language and math.

Q: What are the results of the test used for?

A: The results help the counselors determine which classes each student would be best suited for their freshman year.

Q: What happens if I do not do well on the test?

A: The placement test is just one piece of information used to help with course placement. The Guidance Team may also consult with parents and junior high teachers for input.
