Election Schedule

Wednesday, March 20	Speeches due to Mrs. Taft
Monday, March 25	Video Speeches - Time TBA
Thursday, April 4	Campaign fliers may be posted – with approval stamp
Monday, April 8	Speeches will available with on-line voting
Monday, April 15	Induction during Honors Convocation

***Any deviation from the candidate's written speech will result in removal from the ballot.**

Campaign Materials

- 1) Posters: No larger than poster board (18 x 24)
Limit of three, located in the cafeteria and commons.
Use masking tape only to hang posters
Approval stamp required. (Campaign materials will be removed if approval stamp is not present)
- 2) Fliers: No larger than 9 x 12
Limit of 10
Approval stamp required
- 3) Other materials: Any other materials must be approved by the Student Council Moderator.
- 4) All materials must be appropriate and should reflect desire to serve the student body in a position of leadership. Do not do anything questionable that would compromise your candidacy. You are running for a serious position in school and campaigns should be run accordingly.
- 5) You may come to get your campaign materials approved Thursday April 19, after school.
